Ms. Reese-
I am unable to attend the FDA hearing on 12/2/05, however, I wanted to make a public comment/appeal. I am the mother of a 9 year old child who has been diagnosed with ADHD, combined type since age 5. He receives psychostimulant medication which is very difficult to administer due to his inability to swallow pills. Attempts to mix in with applesauce, yogurt, etc. have failed. My child is subjected to placing sprinkled spansules in a spoon and swallowing dry, followed by milk each morning. I implore the FDA to give serious consideration to the transdermal method of delivery. It would be a welcome addition to the daily management of ADHD for my family as well as countless others across the country. Thank you, in advance, for considering my position in this regard.
