


This is a notification pursuant to 21 U.S.C. 343(r)(6) that Standard Process Inc., Palmyra, Wisconsin 53156-0904, is making the following statements:

1. Chlorophyll contains hormone precursors and activates enzymes to product fat-soluble vitamins A, E, D and K.
2. Vitamin K is involved in the coagulation of blood.
3. Chlorophyll is also a source of magnesium, iron, trace minerals, and lecithin.
