

Dear Sir/Madam:

This is a notification pursuant to 21 U.S.C. 343(r)(6) that Standard Process Inc., Palmyra, Wisconsin 53156-0904, is making the following statements:

1. Chlorophyll is remarkably similar in structure to hemoglobin, the oxygen-carrying pigment found in red blood cells.
2. Chlorophyll contains the fat-soluble vitamin complexes of A, E, F, and K. These vitamins are vital for the normal function and integrity of epithelial tissues; normal calcium and phosphorus metabolism; and the synthesis of healthy blood clotting factors and prothrombin.
3. Chlorophyll provides hormone precursors; strengthens cellular membranes – making them more resistant to free radical attack; and can help the body address the aging process.

These statements are made for a dietary supplement containing fat soluble extract (from sesame seed, alfalfa, *Tillandsia usneoides*, buckwheat, pea (vine), and carrot), and soy bean lecithin. The name of the product is Chlorophyll Complex Perles™.
