

Dear Sir/Madam:

This is a notification pursuant to 21 U.S.C. 343(r)(6) that Standard Process Inc., Palmyra, Wisconsin 53156-0904, is making the following statements:

1. Since the early 1940's, vitamin E has enjoyed a widespread reputation for supporting muscle function.
2. Research reveals that vitamin E helps decrease anoxia of muscle, maintain capillary tone and permeability, promote healthy arterioles, and protect muscle tissues from free radical damage.
3. Vitamin E helps keep the cardiovascular system healthy.

These statements are made for a dietary supplement containing a proprietary blend of bovine orchic extract, inositol, dried pea (vine) juice, ribonucleic acid, oat flour, bovine adrenal, beet (root), bovine spleen, ovine spleen, beet (root) juice, bovine liver, manganese lactate, and ascorbic acid. Other ingredients include honey, selenium yeast, potassium para-aminobenzoate, mixed tocopherols, and arabic gum. The name of the product is Cataplex® E.
