**WARNING LETTER**

Dear Mr. Jman:

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) attempted to examine a shipment of baby corns cereal offered for entry into the United States by your firm on January 28, 1998, under the above referenced entry number, and found that the shipment was not held intact for FDA examination. Regulation 1.90, Title 21, Code of Federal Regulations (21 CFR 1.90) requires the importer to hold an entry intact pending receipt of a "May Proceed Notice" or "Release Notice" from FDA. We have requested the U. S. Customs Service (Customs) to order redelivery of this shipment (copy enclosed).

Failure to promptly correct this violation and prevent future violations may result in regulatory action without further notice such as seizure, injunction, or automatic detention of future shipments. It is your responsibility, as the importer, to ensure that imported products meet all the requirements of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act and the regulations promulgated thereunder.

We request a response in writing within fifteen (15) working days of receipt of this letter of the specific steps you have taken to correct the violation, including an explanation of each step being taken to prevent the recurrence of the violation.
