Dear Mr. Eisen:

During an inspection on December 15, 1999 of Hudson Transit Lines, Bus Service Area at 76 S. Main Street, Liberty, New York, our investigator observed violations of the Public Health Service Act and implementing regulations for the Control of Communicable Diseases and Interstate Conveyance Sanitation (Title 21, Code of Federal Regulations, Parts 1240 and 1250).

At the conclusion of the inspection, our investigator presented to Ms. Judy Van Wagner, Ticket Salesperson, a list of Inspectional Observations, Form FDA 483 (copy attached), and Inspection Summary for Bus Service Area Sanitation, Form FDA 2589 (copy attached). The findings were discussed with Ms. Van Wagner.

The following deviations were observed during the inspection:

- No backflow preventer device in the water line leading to the hose used for flushing and washing the bus sewage retention tank.
- No sign instructing employees to wash their hands before resuming work.


As a result of the above violations, a "Provisional" classification has been assigned for a period of thirty (30) days at which time a reinspection will be conducted. If significant improvement has not been made at that time, a "Not Approved" classification will be justified.

The above violations are not intended to be an all inclusive list of deficiencies which may exist. You should take prompt action to correct these deviations. It is your responsibility to ensure that all requirements of the Public Health Service Act and the regulations promulgated thereunder are being met. Please notify this office in writing within 15 working days of receipt of this letter, of the specific steps you have taken to correct the noted violations.
