Dear Mr. Stout:

On August 6, 1997, a representative of the Food and Drug Administration conducted an inspection of your aircraft servicing facility. This inspection was conducted under the authority of the Public Health Service Act and the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act.

The List of Observations (FDA-483) was issued to and discussed with you.

The inspection revealed significant deviations from the Interstate Conveyance Regulations [21 CFR 1250], as follows:

- 1) Service Cart # 9 was leaking sewage from the dumpvalve onto the rampway.
- 2) Both service carts lack the required "Lavatory Service" labeling.

As a result of these findings, this facility has been classified as "Provisional." A reinspection will be conducted on or about September 6, 1997, to determine if future classification will be "Approved" or "Not Approved." A "Not Approved" classification means you cannot provide water/sewage service to airlines.
