

Reentry for Donors Deferred Because of HIV Test Results



¹ HIV Discriminatory NAT may be Positive or Negative; however, if Negative and if HCV Discriminatory NAT is Positive, use HCV Reentry Algorithm only.

² If a different, licensed HIV-2 EIA is Negative or, if RR, an optional HIV-2 Supplemental Test is Indeterminate or Negative.

³ A Supplemental NAT that is validated for use with individual donations.

⁴ If index sample was Non-Discriminated using Discriminatory NAT for HIV and HCV, test a follow-up sample using HCV NAT also, as in HCV Reentry Algorithm.

⁵ A licensed NAT method that is labeled sensitive for HIV-1 Group O, HIV-1 Group M variants, and HIV-2.

⁶ The original EIA test for HIV-1 and HIV-2 that was run on the index sample, or an Alternate EIA that is labeled sensitive for HIV-1 Group O and HIV-2.

Reentry for Donors Deferred Because of HIV Test Results

Questions for the Committee

1. Is it useful to consider reentry for donors (Group 1) with NAT Positive / Anti-HIV-1/2 EIA RR / HIV-1 Western Blot Indeterminate or Negative results ?
2. Should reentry be considered for donors (in Group 3) with NAT Negative / Anti-HIV-1/2 EIA RR / HIV-1 Western Blot Indeterminate, Viral Bands Present results ?
3. What should be the minimum time period for waiting prior to follow-up testing ?
4. Should the blood establishment have the option of continuing to follow-up a donor with NAT Negative / persistent Anti- HIV-1/2 EIA RR results for possible reentry ?
