REQUEST TO PRESENT FDA, HHS CITIZEN PETITION

There is another matter of proposition which pertains to the above-mentioned case docket, and it's basis lies concurrent with the provisions of the *FDA Backgrounder*. Hence, petitioner is making a cordial request to present within claim for compensation made 5/24/99, firstly, to make aware the Respondent that there remains issues unresolved about the prospective insureds' injurious adverse reactions complained of since taking test-medications prior to this date. These issues correlate directly with the FDA section 10.30 Citizen Petition Format and 10.25 "interested person" comments towards bringing about an amendment, revocation of regulation or order, for it to refrain from bringing about an order or simply to raise or propose other issues on regulations.

Citizen Petition: The undersigned submits this petition under—sections proposed in initial documents prepared and spoken of with the agency's rep., 6/97, secondarily nonetheless according to the *Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act or Public Health Service Act and pursuant to 21 CFR 5.10* to request the Commissioner of the FDA to refrain from and/or initiate a proper action or correspondence which deals with insurance matters regarding unemployment and social security for volunteers.

- A.) Action requested: The main action sought is to apply NJSA 2A:14-2 to ensure just review.
- B.) Statement of grounds: Petitioner respectfully requests that lenience is shown in allowance of reserving his legal right to point out all factors of these issues, first in the ordinary processes of the Claim already being addressed in 2000.
- C.) General impact: In a practical sense the occupation undertaken has not been viewed apart from any other as far as federal allotments are concerned. It also appears that, *economically*, an upgraded labor force may reap some beneficial long-term effect onto the Government by withholding said moneys, and that the human-subjects, too, might well find a better future for their families by the financial support network of modern modifications for the clinical research industry, or for those applicable.


