

RE: Notification of Nutritional Support Statements


Dear Sir or Ma'am:

I hereby notify the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) of the use of statements of nutritional support in the labeling of Metafolin® a dietary supplement. Source Naturals® is the manufacturer of Metafolin®.

Statements being made in the labeling of Metafolin®:

- 1) Metafolin® is a new, coenzymated form of folic acid.
- 2) Upon absorption, folate is converted into L-methylfolate, which is the predominant form of folate in circulation and is the only type of folate that can cross the blood-brain barrier.
- 3) Metafolin® does not require enzymatic conversion that folic acid does which is difficult for some people.
- 4) Preliminary research suggests that it is more bioavailable than folic acid.
