We request a 60-day extension of the comment period for the referenced rule. We make this request so that we can supply reasonable, fact-based responses to several of the questions posed by FDA in the ANPR. Specific questions requiring more time than the current 30-day comment period are as follows:

Questions 12 and 14 regarding data supporting banning the use of Avian MBM (Poultry By-Product Meal or Chicken Meal) in ruminants, and the economic impact of such a ban.

We are currently polling our membership to provide a response to these questions, however, thirty days is simply inadequate for this task.

We appreciate your consideration of our request, and believe providing an extension will provide fact-based information for FDA decision-making.
