Dear Commissioner:

We are concerned that you may approve a proposed generic drug ANDA 76-258. We urge you to deny this drug application.

We are very concerned about adequate pain management, however, this matrix patch will allow fentanyl to be easily consumed orally, and easily shared by simply cutting the patch. This will dramatically increase the potential for abuse of fentanyl in this delivery system. It is NOT a generic equivalent to the Duragesic fentanyl patch.
