Dear Dr. Henney:


I am writing to you to express my deep concern over the Food and Drug Administration's regulation of genetically engineered food. I request that the FDA's current policies be changed, and I support all the points in docket #00P-1211/CPI.

As a consumer I request that all genetically engineered food be labeled so I am informed and have a choice. What could possibly be the matter with such a consumer option?

Genetically engineered foods should not be assumed to be "generally recognized as safe" and should have mandatory pre-market safety testing to determine the long-term impacts to human health and the environment.

Finally, there should be a moratorium on genetically engineered foods until long-term studies show they are safe for human health and the environment.


