

Dear Dr. Henney:

Scientific evidence is quite clear that the continued use of growth-promoting antibiotics in animal feeds threatens the health of American Citizens. We hope the Food and Drug Administration will follow the lead of Europeans and move to ban the use of antibiotics used in human medicine in animal feed. Animal production in countries such as Sweden and Denmark has been modified with a very slight increase in the price of meat and without decreasing the supply. We were advised by our medical doctor to have more immunization for diseases like pneumonia. because the antibiotics that were effective at one time are no longer effective.
