

This is a notification pursuant to 21 U.S.C. 343(r)(6) that Standard Process Inc., Palmyra, Wisconsin 53156-0904, is making the following statements:

1. Cataplex E contains sex hormone precursors and helps protect precious DNA.
2. Vitamin E complex has been shown to support the reproductive, nervous, hematopoietic, cardiovascular, muscular, endocrine, skin, immune, and renal systems.
3. One of the most well established roles of vitamin E is its ability to work as an effective antioxidant, destroying free radicals and helping to protect, stabilize, and repair cell membranes.

These statements are made for a dietary supplement containing a proprietary blend of bovine orchic extract, inositol, dried pea (vine) juice, ribonucleic acid, oat flour, bovine adrenal, beet (root), bovine spleen, ovine spleen, beet (root) juice, bovine liver, manganese lactate, and ascorbic acid. Other ingredients include honey, selenium yeast, potassium para-aminobenzoate, mixed tocopherols, and arabic gum. The name of the product is Cataplex® E.
