I am writing you to voice my concern regarding the lack of oversight in the use of antibiotics in agriculture. I urge you to establish a viable reporting system to determine the quantity of antibiotics used in U.S. agriculture. As a consumer and scientist, I am deeply concerned with the overuse of both antibiotics and pesticides. Growth of the organic agriculture business in the U.S. clearly indicates that the issue of antibiotic use in agriculture is of great concern not only to me, but to many in the U.S. The U.S. Food and Drug Administration has the job of scrutinizing potential hazards in all aspects of U.S. agriculture. I hope that you, in cooperation with the new administration, will make the issue of antibiotic use in agriculture a priority. Only then will U.S. consumers and scientists be able to fully assess the possible ramifications of antibiotic overuse, not the least of which is bacterial drug resistance.
