

RE: Notification of Nutritional Support Statements


Dear Sir or Madam:

I hereby notify the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) of the use of statements of nutritional support in the labeling of, DIM (Diindolylmethane) a dietary supplement. Source Naturals® is the manufacturer of DIM.

Statements being made in the labeling of DIM:

- (1) DIM is an indole phytochemical that is a natural metabolite of compounds found in cruciferous vegetables such as broccoli, Brussels sprouts and cabbage.
- (2) In animal and *in vitro* studies, DIM has been shown to lead to the preferential formation of estrogen metabolites that are correlated with healthy breast, endometrial, and cervical tissues. This unique property sets DIM apart from other plant nutrients.
- (3) Source Naturals DIM is combined with phosphatidyl choline, vitamin E and bioperine for enhanced absorption.
