ORDER

On May 14, 2003, non-party participant Animal Health Institute (AHI) filed a Motion seeking clarification of the Notice and Order dated May 9, 2003, which established the briefing schedule. The AHI requested to file an initial brief, not to exceed 50 pages, on or before July 18, 2003, and a reply brief, not to exceed 25 pages, on or before August 15, 2003. Additionally, the AHI requested that the Center for Veterinary Medicine be allowed to file a reply brief, not to exceed 25 pages.

Pursuant to 21 CFR § 12.89 (a)(3), non-party participant AHI may file briefs. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that AHI may file an initial brief not to exceed 50 pages, and a reply brief not to exceed 25 pages.

And **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Center for Veterinary Medicine may file an additional reply brief not to exceed 25 pages.
