
Dear Mr. Bonilla:

Thank you for your letter regarding a petition to establish the descriptive claims "excellent source," "good source," and "made with" for whole grain content of foods. You stated that the Food and Drug Administration's (FDA) approval of the petition would be wholly consistent with the goal of the Department of Health and Human Services to work towards a healthier America and with FDA's Consumer Health Information for Better Nutrition Initiative. The petition, received on May 11, is currently under review at FDA's Center for Food Safety and Applied Nutrition.

As you may know, guidelines for increased consumption of whole grain foods have been laid out in the *2000 Dietary Guidelines for Americans* and the U.S. Department of Agriculture's *Food Guide Pyramid*.
