Dear Sir or Madam,

Our area is being fluoridated in the near future.

I put this down to the fact of the ADA endorsement of this as both "safe and effective". In doing this the ADA has in effect held itself out as experts and it is in fact the intent of these assurances that they be relied upon and that fluoridation is implemented in as many communities as possible. These assurances are also held out in such a way that they induce members of the public to be assured that this is in fact a safe product. This is to be the likely effect of such a long standing and respected organisation such as your own.

I note the numerous representations to effect that water fluoridation is both "safe and effective" that your organisation has made and submitted to government enquiries, etc.

I now have placed reliance on your assurances as a professional body that this is in fact the case and the practice of water fluoridation is both "safe and effective" regardless of the health status or personal consumption of the persons who now have no option but to ingest water thus medicated.

I believe that such assurances and undertakings are sufficient to attach liability to the ADA for any harm or lack of efficacy of any of the compounds of fluorine that are added for the purpose that they are to be ingested as to cause such health effects.

I believe that this also attaches liability for the form of the chemical that is added to achieve the "optimal" level of fluoride in domestic drinking water supplies, where this form also results in the intentional addition of lead, mercury, cadmium, arsenic, other heavy metals and or radionucleotides where it is the common practice to add such chemicals and the ADA has not opposed this methodology of delivery to the end consumer, without the consumers consent.

I hold the ADA to their assurance of the safety and efficacy of any substance so added to accomplish the medication (fluoridation) of the water supply to achieve the "optimal" health of the end consumer.

I hereby give notice that I hold the -

Australian Dental Association and its members jointly and severably thus legally liable for any detriment, harm, loss, damage or defects thus caused by or contributed to by the addition of fluoridating chemicals into public water drinking supplies. Such liability shall extend but in no way be limited to, myself and my wife and our family, our livestock and crops, our property, our land, our waterways and waterbodies both permanent and seasonal and generally of our environment.
