This letter is in regards to [REDACTED]'s right-sided posterior positional plagiocephaly. We discussed on the phone the possibility of providing [REDACTED] with a molding helmet for his positional plagiocephaly, which had been our recommendation. Apparently his insurance does not cover the Cranial Therapies molding helmet and they have recommended the use of a Star Band.

Our experience with the Star Band is that it has not been as effective in terms of correcting the positional plagiocephaly as the Doc Band that is provided by Cranial Therapies. Our position is not to use the Star Band, but rather to use the Doc Band from Cranial Therapies. I discussed the advantages of the Doc Band versus the Star Band with both Dr. McComb and Dr. Krieger. They both agree that in their experience the Doc Band is superior to the Star Band in terms of correcting positional plagiocephaly.
