Greetings,

I wish to object to the changes proposed in Docket entry 2007P-0085: Adopt Regulations of General Applicability to all Food Standards that would Permit, within Stated Boundaries, Deviations from the Requirements of the Individual Food Standards of Identity.

I find that it is a very important part of food labeling to have foods be labeled as what they are. If I buy a chocolate candy bar, I expect it to contain chocolate, not some reasonable substitute that has been labeled 'chocolate' because it's close enough. I use the nutritional labeling on the package to determine which chocolate bar to buy, but I don't want to have to use it to determine if it's really chocolate.

I urge you to reject this petition.
