Subpart B--Listing of Specific Substances Affirmed as GRAS

Sec. 184.1911 Triethyl citrate.

(a) Triethyl citrate (C<sub>12</sub>H<sub>20</sub>O<sub>7</sub>, </p></div>

(b) The ingredient meets the specifications of the Food Chem. Codex, 3d ed. (1981), p. 339, which is incorporated by reference in accordance with 5 U.S.C. 552(a) and 1 CFR part 51. Copies are available from the National Academy Press, 2101 Constitution Ave. NW., Washington, DC 20418, and the Center for Food Safety and Applied Nutrition (1000 200), 200 C St. SW., Washington, DC 20204, or may be examined at the Office of the Federal Register, 800 North Capitol St. NW., suite 700, Washington, DC.

(c) In accordance with Sec. 184.1(b)(1), the ingredient is used in human food with no limitation other than current good manufacturing practice. The affirmation of this ingredient as generally recognized as safe (GRAS) as a direct human food ingredient is based upon the following current good manufacturing practice conditions of use:

(1) The ingredient is used as a flavoring agent as defined in Sec. 170.3(o)(12) of this chapter; a solvent and vehicle as defined in Sec. 170.3(o)(27) of this chapter; and a surface-active agent as defined in Sec. 170.3(o)(29) of this chapter.

(2) The ingredient is used in foods at levels not to exceed current good manufacturing practice.

(d) Prior sanctions for this ingredient different from the usual

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established in this section, or different from those set forth in 181 of this chapter, do not exist or have been waived.
