
Pursuant to Section 6 of the Dietary Supplement Health and Education Act of 1994, Tyler Encapsulations wishes to notify the Food and Drug Administration that it will within the next 30 days commence to market a dietary supplement which bears statements of nutritional support.

The dietary supplement for which the statements are made is Bean & Vegi Enzyme Formula. The dietary ingredients that are the subject of the statements are alpha-galactosidase, amylase, cellulase, protease and lipase. The statements of nutritional support are as follows:

1. Digestive dietary supplement.
2. The enzyme alpha-galactosidase reduces intestinal gas production by enhancing the breakdown of certain carbohydrates.
3. Contains additional enzymes for digestion of fiber, proteins, carbohydrates and fats.
4. Contains plant enzymes which aid in the digestion of beans, legumes, cabbage, broccoli, eggplant, chickpeas, soy and other vegetable products which can produce gas in some individuals.
