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Dear Sir or Madam,

Pursuant to Section 6 of the Dietary Supplement Health and Education Act of 1994, Tyler Encapsulations wishes to notify the Food and Drug Administration that it will within the next 30 days commence to market a dietary supplement which bears statements of nutritional support.

The dietary supplement for which the statements are made is Similase, Jr. The dietary ingredients that are the subject of the statements are protease, amylase, lipase, cellulase, lactase, invertase and malt diastase. The statements of nutritional support are as follows:

1. Complete digestive enzymes for children.
2. Supports digestion of proteins, carbohydrates, fats, fiber and sugars under virtually all gastrointestinal pH conditions.
3. Enzymes in Similase, Jr. digest dietary proteins, fats, starch, lactose, sucrose, maltose and fiber beginning in the stomach and continuing in the small intestine.
