

Method of Collection

9 whole, raw cantaloupes were randomly selected from (b) (4) cases of cantaloupes received on 9/8/11, which were stored in ambient storage. A 10th cantaloupe was selected randomly from the (b) (4) case. Each case contained 9 cantaloupes. Subs were collected using aseptic technique and placed in sterile stomacher bags. Subs 1-5 were placed into one cooler with frozen ice packs. Subs 6-10 were placed into a second cooler with frozen ice packs.

How Prepared

The two cooler's containing the subs and ice packs were placed into a GOV car and driven back to the DEN-DO office. Once at DEN-DO, tape was wrapped around each cooler. Each cooler was then sealed with "INV643701 9/9/11 Jennifer A. Baker". Form FDA-525's were attached to each cooler. The coolers were hand walked to the DEN-DO Sample Custodian.

Remarks

The Ingredient Supplier was the (b) (4) from which cantaloupes were collected had no documentation showing the delivery of product to the firm. The firm's Store Manager (b) (4) stated that the documentation is kept at the (b) (4) had closed for the business day by the time I began my sample collection.

All (b) (4) cases delivered to the firm on 9/8/11 were present in storage and unopened.

Open and closed controls were included with the cooler containing subs 1-5.

Collector's Identification on Package and/or Label:

"INV643701 Sub# (1-10) JB 9/9/11" was written on each sub containing whirl-pack. After returning to the office, I realized that I should have identified the subs as "INV643701 9/9/11 JB Sub (1-10)".
