
OBSERVATION 1

Your written SE prevention plan lacks appropriate SE prevention measures.

Specifically,

Your SE prevention plan titled "WR Cramer Ranch Company Policy" dated 03/21/11 does not include the following:

- (a) Measures to procure pullets that are SE monitored, raise pullets under SE monitored conditions or to conduct testing of the pullet environment for SE when the pullets are 14-16 weeks of age.
- (b) An established procedure to hold eggs at or below 45 degrees ambient temperature beginning 36 hours after time of lay.
- (c) Practices that will protect against cross-contamination when equipment is moved among poultry houses.
- (d) Practices that will protect against cross-contamination when people move among poultry houses.
- (e) Not allowing employees to keep birds at home.
- (f) Procedures that address cleaning and disinfection of poultry houses if an environmental or egg test was positive for SE in your poultry houses at any point during the life of the flock.
- (g) A procedure for egg sampling or a procedure to divert the eggs to treatment for the life of the flock if an environmental test was positive for SE in your poultry houses at any point during the life of the flock.

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OBSERVATION 2

Your written SE prevention plan is not fully implemented and followed.

Specifically, your SE prevention plan titled "WR Cramer Ranch Company Policy" dated 03/21/11 states "when wild birds, rodents, or other animals (dead or alive) are found within the layer house, safely remove when possible, and make a notation on the (b)(4) Log." We reviewed your "WR Cramer Ranches (b)(4) Log" for all five houses from June 2010 to March 2011 and we did not observe any notation of pests found. On 03/22/11, we observed one dead rodent in house #3, one live and five dead rodents in house #2, and four dead rodents in the exterior grounds between house #2 and #3.

OBSERVATION 3

Stray animals are not prevented from entering poultry houses.

Specifically,

House #1

A hole approximately 6 inches in diameter was observed along the West facing wall.

House #2

An approximate 6 foot long and 3 inch wide gap was observed between the cement foundation and the chicken wiring along the bottom of the North facing wall.

An approximate 3 inch gap was observed at the corner of the North and East facing walls where a pipe enters the poultry house.

One live rodent was observed between rows (b)(4) in the poultry house.

Five dead rodents were observed on the North facing wall of the poultry house.

House #3

One dead rodent was observed between rows (b)(4)

Three live wild birds were observed perching in the rafters above rows (b)(4)

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OBSERVATION 4

You did not maintain records documenting compliance with rodent and other pest control measures.

Specifically, your SE prevention plan titled "WR Cramer Ranch Company Policy" dated 03/21/11 under Protection states that "Bait Stations are to be monitored **b(4)** and refilled as needed. When results are out of the ordinary, make a notation on the **b(4)** Log."

- (a) You do not have monitoring records for the activities of rodents and flies for any of your five poultry houses.
- (b) You did not set an indication of an unacceptable activity of pests.

OBSERVATION 5

Eggs were not held at or below 45 deg. F beginning 36 hours after time of lay.


Specifically, your delivery records from July 2010 to March 2011 showed eggs were picked up after 36 hours from time of lay; however, there were no indications that eggs were held at or below 45 degrees F during storage.

OBSERVATION 6

Your written SE plan does not carry the signature(s) and not the initials of the person(s) who administer the plan.

Specifically, your original SE prevention plan titled "WR Cramer Ranch Company Policy" dated 05/28/10, and your current SE prevention plan titled "WR Cramer Ranch Company Policy" dated 03/21/11, were not signed by the persons administering the plans.
