**DURING AN INSPECTION OF YOUR FIRM WE OBSERVED:**

**OBSERVATION 1**

The poultry house environmental sampling plan was not appropriate to the poultry house layout.

Specifically, your established procedures for environmental swabbing referred to in your SE plan identify (b) (4) as the preferred sample type instead of manure samples. The manure belts are easily accessible for swabbing.

**OBSERVATION 2**

Your pullet environment is not tested for SE when pullets are 14 to 16 weeks of age.

Specifically, your SE plan indicates that the pullet environment is tested when pullets are 12-14 weeks of age. Your record "Farm Results Using FDA Approved NPIP Testing Methods for Minnesota Pullets" indicates that since the implementation of the Egg Rule in July, 2010, the pullet environment has been routinely tested when pullets are between 12-13 weeks of age.
