The text of each structure function claim for **Calcium, Magnesium & Vitamin D** is as follows:

- (Statement 1) Krebs Cycle and Mineral Transport Complexers
- (Statement 2) Calcium is needed for normal bone and teeth development, blood clotting, enzymatic action, and the regulation of fluid passage through walls of tissue and cells.
- (Statement 3) Magnesium is an essential mineral to the enzyme systems that are responsible for energy conversion in the body. Magnesium also helps to regulate proper calcium metabolism.
