

Tylosin Phosphate and Sulfamethazine Medicated Swine Feed – Dysentery Type C Medicated Feed

CAUTION: Federal law restricts medicated feed containing this veterinary feed directive (VFD) drug to use by or on the order of a licensed veterinarian.

INDICATION

For prevention of swine dysentery associated with *Brachyspira hyodysenteriae*;

Tylosin phosphate ^a	100 g/ton
Sulfamethazine ^a	100 g/ton

Do not use in any finished feed (supplement, concentrate or complete feed) containing in excess of 2% bentonite.

WARNING

Withdraw 15 days before swine are slaughtered.
