I left a message for Dr. Kenimer in response to his email copied below.

1. I fixed the address in the system and let those involved know to send things to the new address, so hopefully this fixes the ongoing problem.
2. Supplements will be processed no matter who they are addressed to. I'm not aware of the specific reason that Dr. Baylor is listed in the acknowledgement letters rather than a division director.
3. The PREA proposal sent 12/22/06 to file 103738/5019 (germalls) is generally acceptable with regard to ages for waiver and deferral. We will look at clinical protocol to be submitted in March. Mekos is likely to send same proposal to all supplements, and that is acceptable/desirable.
