**1. Detroit Laboratory (DCIFBC).**

- A. Plans, schedules, and controls laboratory operations; and formulates, implements, and coordinates laboratory work plans with offices served.
- B. Performs laboratory analysis of samples to:
  - 1. Assess their compliance with laws and regulations enforced by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA).
  - 2. Obtain information through national surveillance programs for the purpose of identifying potential problems or trends.
- C. Provides evidence regarding analytical findings as requested.
- D. Conducts research to develop and refine methodology used in the analysis of samples and to explore new systems of analysis.
- E. Implements an effective internal quality assurance program to assure the reliability of analytical results.
- F. Serves as a resource in scientific knowledge and provides expert advice and training regarding laboratory techniques and technological developments to other Federal agencies, State and local agencies, foreign counterpart agencies, and industry.
- G. Maintains liaison with scientists and scientific bodies with interests pertinent to laboratory activities.

- H. Provides analytical support to Headquarters components as needed.
- I. Conducts the equal employment opportunity, internal security, safety and emergency preparedness programs.
- J. Participates in team inspections as necessary.

**2. Authority and Effective Date.**

The functional statements for the Detroit Laboratory were approved by the Secretary for Health and Human Services and effective on December 14, 2018.
