Specialties include, but are not limited to: Internal Medicine, Cardiology, Oncology and Hematology, Infectious Disease, Neurology, Family Medicine, Emergency Medicine, Transfusion Medicine, Anesthesiology, Pediatrics, etc. Multiple positions are available throughout the various Center Offices.

Job Description

Physicians and Medical Officers serve as clinical experts in the review and evaluation of trials and clinical development programs for investigational biologic products for safety, biological activity, and efficacy. They have an important role in the approval process for biologic products by virtue of their extensive knowledge of clinical trial design and evaluation of results from a broad multidisciplinary background which allows for critical assessment of the rationale, safety, and adequacy of study design and interpretation of results. The specific duties and grade level of each Physician or Medical Officer position may vary depending on the selecting Office.

Key Requirements

One year probationary period may be required; Official transcripts required; Must possess a current, active, full, and unrestricted license or registration as a Physician from a State, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, or a territory of the United States.

Qualifications

Doctor of Medicine, Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine or equivalent from a school in the United States or Canada. Degree must have been accredited at the time the degree was obtained.
