SCIENTIFIC CONFERENCE GRANT PROGRAM

Program Description

- Facilitates federal financial assistance in support of small conferences and *scientific meetings* clearly defined within the FDA mission.
- Provides funding to organizations, associations, academia, as well as state, local and tribal governments.
- Awards up to \$25,000 per application.
- Awards provided twice a year (calendar year).
- Provides financial assistance to support various organizations, allowing them to meet and collaborate on current and emerging food, feed, drug and device issues impacting health and safety.

Intended Outcomes

- The purpose is to facilitate the provision of federal financial assistance in support of small conferences and scientific meetings clearly aligned with the FDA mission.
