Validated Analytical Testing

Testing harmonization and limits

- Potency
- Foreign matter
- Loss on drying
- Pesticides
- Microbial and fungi
- Heavy metals
- Residual solvents
- Sampling
- Proficiency testing

Pesticide Testing Requirements	California	Colorado	Oregon	Washington
Abamectin	0.3ppm	0.07ppm	0.5ppm	Screen
Imidacloprid	3ppm	0.02ppm	0.4ppm	Screen
Myclobutanil	9ppm	0.04ppm	0.2ppm	Screen
Permethrin (cis + trans)	20ppm	0.04ppm	0.2ppm	Screen
Spinosad	3ppm	0.06ppm	0.2ppm	Screen
Spiromesifen	12ppm	0.03ppm	0.2ppm	Screen

Safety Concerns

Pesticides

- Recalls in states like Colorado, Oregon, and Washington for use of nonpermitted pesticides or exceeding allowable limits
- No Special Local Needs Registrations have been approved by EPA despite 4 states applying

Residual solvents

- Use of solvents varies by state
- Recall in Colorado for ethanol exceeding allowable limit
- Some locations permit hydrocarbons such as butane and propane
- Equipment used in manufacturing



Safety Concerns

- Potency of THC-rich products
 - Weight and rate of metabolism
 - Amount and type consumed
 - Method of consumption
 - Experience with cannabis
- Homogeneity
 - Distribution of cannabinoids in products that have multiple servings
