Mammograms are the best way to screen for breast cancer. However, many women still do not get regular mammography screenings. The **FDA Office of Women's Health** launched the Pink Ribbon Sunday Mammography Awareness Program in 1998 to educate women about early detection of breast cancer through mammography. Pink Ribbon Sunday originally targeted African American and Hispanic churches, but the program has since expanded to all types of organizations serving women from diverse ethnic, religious, and social backgrounds. Activities are held every day of the week – not just on Sunday.
