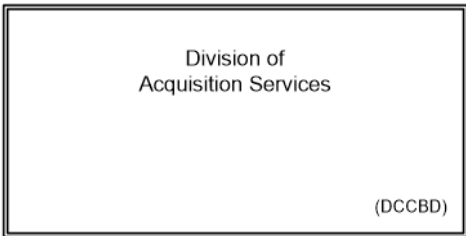
1. Division of Acquisition Services (DCCBD).

- A. Provides leadership and direction for CDRH's acquisitions activities, such as developing and coordinating acquisitions packages and providing advice and guidance to Center management.
- B. Serves as a liaison between the Center and the Food and Drug Administration's acquisitions and grants programs to ensure timely and proper execution of contracts.
- C. Provides guidance and assistance on new and/or amended acquisition law, regulations, requirements and policies to include professional certification requirements for the Center Contracting Officer Representatives (COR) acquisition community.

2. Authority and Effective Date.
