1. Office of Policy (DCCG).

- A. Provides oversight and leadership in the development of regulations, policies, procedures and guidances concerning medical device and radiation-emitting products under the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act.
- B. Provides leadership in Center-level legislative activities, including the development and evaluation of legislation, responses to congressional inquiries, and briefings for congressional members and their staff.
- C. Coordinates the development, review and submission of Federal Register publications for the Center. Prepares position statements for the Center on standards promulgated by other organizations.
- D. Provides leadership and expertise in the planning and implementation of proposals for new regulations and policy statements.

2. Authority and Effective Date.

The functional statements for the Office of Policy were approved by the Secretary of Health and Human Services and effective on December 14, 2018.
