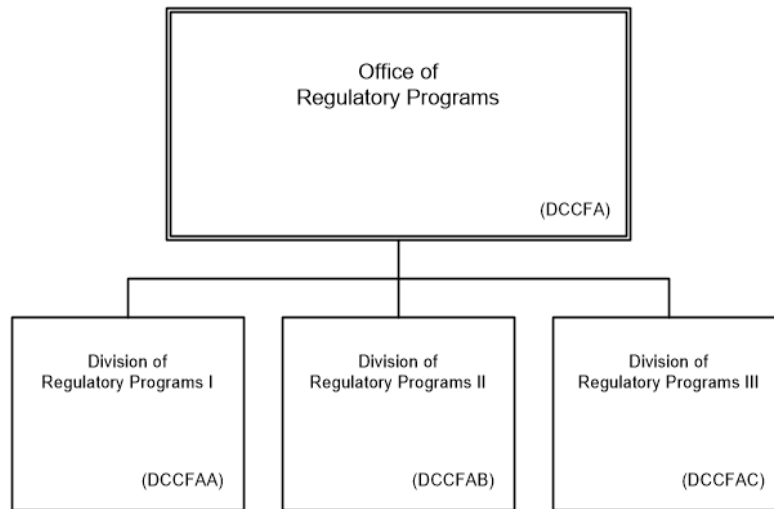
1. Office of Regulatory Programs (DCCFA).

- A. Responsible for managing the various regulatory programs and providing high-level programmatic support for device specific offices engaging in total product life cycle review of devices.
- B. Provides programmatic expertise, develops policy interpretations and analysis, provides review processes and tools, and addresses novel or complex policy exceptions for purposes of ensuring consistency among device specific offices.
- C. Provides logistical support on document control, automated systems, quality assurance, and corrections to device submissions for device specific offices.
- D. Ensures the proper application of Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and Center for Devices and Radiological Health (CDRH) policy to jurisdictional decisions including 513(g) reviews device determinations and custom devices.

2. Authority and Effective Date.

The functional statements for the Office of Regulatory Programs were approved by the Secretary of Health and Human Services and effective on December 14, 2018.
