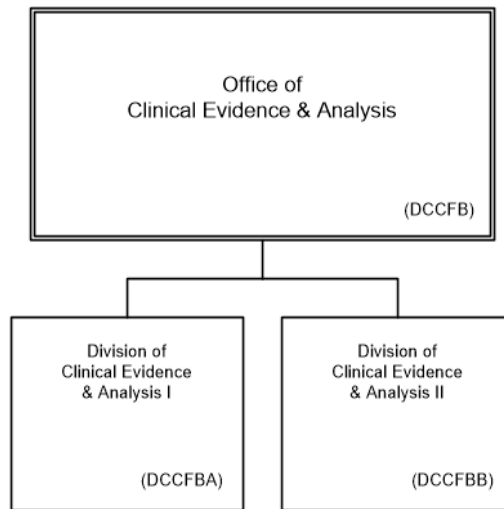
1. Office of Clinical Evidence and Analysis (DCCFB).

- A. Responsible for providing policy and program support regarding clinical evidence and human subject protection and for supporting device reviews that require expert clinical investigation and real world evidence analysis.
- B. Provides analysis and support on biostatistics and epidemiologic analyses, as well as data infrastructure and expertise on clinical investigations and real world evidence. Provides high-level programmatic support for Device Specific Offices engaging in total product life cycle review of devices.
- C. Conducts outreach and collaboration with hospitals and other external stakeholders.

2. Authority and Effective Date.

The functional statements for the Office of Clinical Evidence and Analysis were approved by the Secretary of Health and Human Services and effective on December 14, 2018.
