1. Division of Standards Implementation (DCIHBC).

- A. Develops and revises regulatory program standards such as the Manufactured Food Regulatory Program Standards (MFRPS) and Animal Feed Regulatory Program standards (AFRPS).
- B. Provides technical support and guidance to states that are implementing, or considering implementation of, regulatory program standards.
- C. Collaborates with state cooperative program staffs in the Office of Regulatory Affairs (ORA) and the Centers to provide technical support and guidance for cooperative program areas.
- D. Collaborates across ORA and with Centers and external alliances and associations to implement a system of continuous improvement and training for regulatory program standards.

2. Authority and Effective Date.

The functional statements for the Division of Standards Implementation were approved by the Secretary of Health and Human Services and effective on December 14, 2018.
