1. Division of Foreign Human and Animal Food Operations East (DCIEBA).

- A. Coordinates and directs foreign human and animal food investigative activities.
- B. Serves as subject matter experts on foreign operations relative to human and animal food program on internal cross-Food and Drug Administration (FDA) committees, workgroups and task forces.
- C. Supports foodborne outbreak and animal food-related emergency response activities.
- D. Serves as operational liaison for foreign human and animal food products inspection programs to FDA's foreign and other offices.
- E. Manages the foreign human and animal food inspection cadre.
- F. Inspects foreign human and animal food establishments for which the Center for Food Safety and Applied Nutrition (CFSAN) and the Center for Veterinary Medicine (CVM) has regulatory responsibilities, collects samples for analysis, performs field examinations and prepares reports.
- G. Evaluates inspectional and analytical findings relative to compliance and recommends appropriate follow-up.
- H. Monitors emerging issues and advancements in human and animal food technology.

2. Foreign Human and Animal Food Inspection Branch 1 (DCIEBA1)

- A. Coordinates and directs foreign human and animal food investigative activities.
- B. Serves as subject matter experts on foreign operations relative to human and animal food program on internal cross-FDA committees, workgroups and task forces.
- C. Supports foodborne outbreak and animal food-related emergency response activities.
- D. Serves as operational liaison for foreign human and animal food products inspection programs to FDA's foreign and other offices.
- E. Manages the foreign human and animal food inspection cadre.

- B. Supports the development and implementation of foreign inspectional work plans.

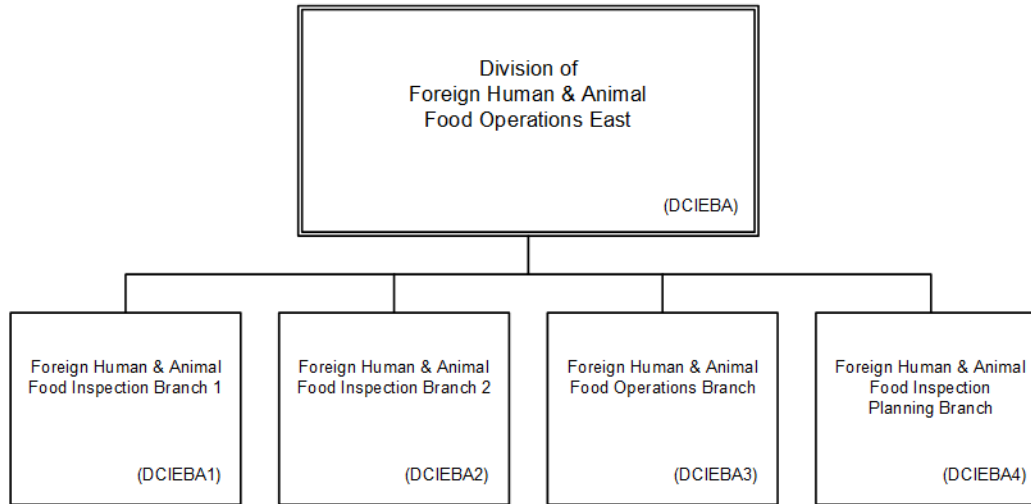
5. Foreign Human and Animal Food Inspection Planning Branch (DCIEBA4)
