

History of the Proposed Produce Safety Rule / Rulemaking Process

January 4 2011	Food Safety Modernization Act (FSMA) signed into law by President Obama	
January 4 2013	FDA released for public comment its Proposed Rule to establish science-based standards for growing, harvesting, packing & holding produce on domestic & foreign farms ("Produce Safety Rule")	
January 16	FDA nublished Dreneed Dule in the Federal Degister	



February 15 **2013**

FDA extended the comment period for the Proposed Rule until May 16, 2013



FDA made technical corrections to the Proposed Rule

August 16 **2013**

FDA extended the comment period for the Proposed Rule until November 15, 2013

FDA announced its intent to prepare an EIS & the beginning of the "scoping process"

FDA published Notice to Prepare an EIS



Proposed Rule until November 22, 2013



in the Federal Register

December 19 **2013** FDA indicated that it plans to publish revised Proposed Rule language for select provisions and seek comment on it



FDA extended the comment period for the Notice to Prepare an EIS until March 15, 2014

March 11 **2014**

FDA published NOI extending scoping to April 18 & announcing EIS Scoping Meeting

April 18 **2014**

End of EIS Scoping Period
