## **Division of Regulatory Operations for Nonprescription Drugs**

### 1. Division of Regulatory Operations for Nonprescription Drugs (DCDGLC).

- A. Serves as the regulatory leader on product-specific review teams, providing day-to-day regulatory guidance to review staff on product-specific issues.
- B. Provides office and division leadership with regulatory expertise on nonprescription products and cross-cutting programs, ensuring consistency with legal and regulatory requirements, as well as office-wide policies.
- C. Manages and coordinates regulatory operations for a portfolio of regulated products, from the investigational stage through marketing application review and post-marketing oversight.
- D. Functions as the communication liaison between other offices within Office of New Drugs, centers, Food and Drug Administrations and the regulated industry for product-specific interactions.
- E. Collaborates in the design and implementation of processes and policies as needed to ensure compliance with relevant laws, regulations, and user fee program commitments.

### 2. Authority and Effective Date.

The functional statements for the Division of Regulatory Operations for Nonprescription Drugs were approved by the Secretary of Health and Human Services on September 25, 2019.
