
1. Office of Drug Evaluation Science (DCDGN).

- A. Supports Office of New Drug's (OND) mission to foster advances in drug development by providing focused scientific expertise on the development and implementation of novel drug development tools, including clinical outcome assessments, and biomarkers.
- B. Supports OND's patient focused drug development activities to incorporate the patient's voice in drug development.
- C. Facilitates the development of tools and practices for the robust analysis and interpretation of data to support clinical assessment and decision-making.
- D. Supports OND's research portfolio management to promote advancements in regulatory science and foster drug development.
