This is to notify you that your request to incorporate changes in the Instructions for Use (IFU) of the Dimension Vista SARS-CoV-2 Total Antibody Assay (COV2T) regarding: (1) extension of onboard stability of unopened reagents from 14 days to 30 days; (2) Extension of the open well stability from 2 days to 3 days; (3) extension of stability of samples from 4 days to 7 days when stored at 2-8°C; (4) extension of calibration frequency from 7 days to 14 days; (5) correction of precision range description; (6) update the precision data generated from 5 days to 20 days; (7) correct typographic errors in slope goal description in the specimen equivalency section and the title of the EP07 document; and (8) addition of a caution section with steps to follow when using software version 3.9.2 to prevent reagent carryover is granted. Upon review, we concur that the data and information submitted in EUA201459/S001 supports the requested updates for use with the Dimension Vista SARS-CoV-2 Total Antibody Assay (COV2T).
