NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

An award is anticipated to be made by the Food and Drug Administration for the acquisition of Diesel Fuel for Muirkirk Road Campus (MRC) Generators to ensure MRC will sustain operation with building HVAC and emergency power capabilities if loss of power was to occur for The Center for Food Safety and Applied Nutrition's (CFSAN).

The Contractor shall provide all necessary materials, labor, permits, hauling, equipment, shipping, delivery, and supervision for protecting existing equipment and all other Government property. The contractor shall also be certified and ensure all work adheres to current industry standards as well as all applicable local, county, ASTM, OSHA, NEC and ASME, codes and specifications.

The Vendor shall Provide No 2 Dye Diesel to FDA MRC site & fill existing tank.

Provide a total of 500 gallons as follows:

1. 4, 200-gallon delivery by metered truck for filling MOD 1 East Side Generator Tank #6, MOD-1 West Side Generator Tanks #1 & #2, MOD-2 D-1 Generator and Boiler Tanks #4 & #5, BRF Tank #3.
2. Metered truck to top off all tanks listed above, Tank #1, #2, #3, #4, #5 and #6.

All work will be completed adhering to FDA Design Guidelines, all Local City, County, State, ASME, ASTM, NFPA, OSHA, UL, ANSI, IEEE, WSSC, rules and regulations and standards set forth by these organizations.

Responses must be in writing and must be received within seven (7) calendar days from the date of this notice. A determination by the Government not to compete the proposed contract based on responses from this notice is solely within the discretion of the Government. Information received will be considered solely for the purpose of determining whether to conduct a competitive procurement.

Delivery of service: To meet the purpose and objective of this requirement, the services shall be provided within thirty days of the date of award.
