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1. BACKGROUND

1.1. ORIGINAL TOBACCO PRODUCTS

The original tobacco products are combusted, filtered cigarettes manufactured by the applicant as indicated on the cover page of this review.

1.2. REGULATORY ACTIVITY RELATED TO THIS REVIEW

On February 27, 2020, FDA received seven Exemption Requests (EX0000997-EX0001003) from ITG Brands, LLC. On March 4, 2020, FDA issued an acceptance letter to the applicant. On March 24, 2020, FDA sent an email with clarification questions for EX0000999, EX0001000, and EX0001003 to the applicant. ITG Brands, LLC submitted an amendment in response to these clarification questions (EX0001031) on March 31, 2020.

1.3. SCOPE OF REVIEW

This review captures all regulatory, compliance, and scientific reviews completed for these Exemption Requests.

1.4. TOBACCO ADDITIVE MODIFICATION

The new tobacco products contain the following modification compared to the corresponding original tobacco products:

- deleting an additive (non-porous tipping paper) in all the EX Requests
- adding an additive (non-porous tipping paper) in all the EX Requests
- deleting an additive (in the tipping paper ink) in EX0000997, EX0000998, and EX0001001 – EX0001003
- adding an additive (b) (4) in the tipping paper ink) in EX0000997, EX0000998, and EX0001001 EX0001003
- increasing the quantity of an existing additive ((b) (4) in the tipping paper ink) in EX0000997

2. REGULATORY REVIEW

Regulatory reviews were completed by Elizabeth Eydelman on March 4, 2020. The reviews conclude that the Exemption Requests are administratively complete.

3. COMPLIANCE REVIEW

For EX0000997, EX0000998, and EX0001000 – EX0001003, the Office of Compliance and Enforcement (OCE) completed a review to determine whether the applicant established that the original tobacco products are grandfathered products (i.e., were commercially marketed in the United States other than exclusively in test markets as of February 15, 2007). The OCE review dated April 1, 2020 concludes that the original tobacco products are grandfathered products. For EX0000999, the original tobacco product was determined to be exempt from the requirements of

section 905(j) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (FD&C Act) relating to the demonstration of substantial equivalence by FDA. A report under section 905(j)(1)(A)(ii) (Abbreviated Report) was submitted, and at least 90 days have elapsed since receipt of the Abbreviated Report by FDA. Therefore, the original tobacco products are eligible for modification under the Exemption Request pathway.¹

4. SCIENTIFIC REVIEW

A scientific review was completed by Jiu Ali on April 9, 2020.

The review states that the new tobacco products have been modified by adding or deleting tobacco additives and increasing the quantity of an existing additive. Tipping paper and tipping paper ink2 are used in the manufacturing of the original tobacco products, and are additives because their intended use may reasonably be expected to result, directly or indirectly, in their becoming a component or otherwise affecting the characteristics of the tobacco products. The review concludes that the modifications are minor modifications of a tobacco product in accordance with section 905(j)(3)(A)(i) of the FD&C Act. The review concludes that the deletion of non-porous tipping paper and the addition of an alternate non-porous tipping paper is a minor modification. The tipping paper between the new and original products contain minimal differences in the additives that compose the tipping papers. In addition, there was no change in the perforation during manufacturing. For EX0000997, EX0000998, and EX0001001 - EX0001003, the review concludes that the deletion of (b) (4) in the tipping paper ink of the original tobacco products and the addition of (b) (4) in the tipping paper ink of the new tobacco products is a minor modification. This modification resulted in a change in composition of the tipping paper ink but did not alter the overall total amount of tipping paper ink as these two additives were changed at equal amounts. Finally, for EX0000997 only, the existing additive of (b) (4) paper ink was increased by (b) (4) mg/cigarette. Overall, these modifications are not expected to materially affect any other characteristic (materials, ingredients, design, composition, heating source, or other features) of the tobacco products.

5. ENVIRONMENTAL DECISION

An environmental review was completed by Bria Martin on March 20, 2020.

For EX0000997, EX0000998, and EX0001000 – EX0001003, a finding of no significant impact (FONSI) was signed by Kimberly Benson, Ph.D. on April 15, 2020. The FONSI was supported by an environmental assessment prepared by FDA on April 15, 2020.

For EX0000999, the environmental review found that the applicant did not provide the overall market volumes from concurrent marketing of the new and original tobacco products. Therefore, additional information is needed to determine whether to prepare an environmental impact statement (EIS) or finding of no significant impact (FONSI).

6. CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATION

The new tobacco products contain the following modification compared to the corresponding original tobacco products:

- deleting an additive (non-porous tipping paper) in all the EX Requests
- adding an additive (non-porous tipping paper) in all the EX Requests
- deleting an additive ((b) (4) in the tipping paper ink) in EX0000997, EX0000998, and EX0001001 EX0001003
- adding an additive ((b) (4) in the tipping paper ink) in EX0000997, EX0000998, and EX0001001 EX0001003
- increasing the quantity of an existing additive ((b) (4) in the tipping paper ink) in EX0000997

I concur with the conclusion of the scientific review that these modifications are minor modifications of a tobacco product in accordance with section 905(j)(3)(A)(i) of the FD&C Act. Section 900(1) of the FD&C Act defines "additive" as "any substance the intended use of which results or may reasonably be expected to result, directly or indirectly, in its becoming a component or otherwise affecting the characteristic of any tobacco product (including any substances intended for use as a flavoring or coloring or in producing, manufacturing, packing, processing, preparing, treating, packaging, transporting, or holding), . . . " I concur with the scientific review that the tipping paper is an addition/deletion of tobacco additives for all EX Requests, and an addition/deletion was made to an additive of the composition of the tipping paper ink for EX0000997, EX0000998, and EX0001001 – EX0001003. In addition, it is my conclusion that, consistent with section 905(j)(3)(A)(ii) of the FD&C Act, an SE Report is not necessary to ensure that permitting the new tobacco products to be marketed would be appropriate for the protection of the public health. The deletion of non-porous tipping paper and the addition of an alternate non-porous tipping paper is a minor modification. The tipping paper between the new and original products contain minimal differences in the additives that compose the tipping papers. In addition, there was no change in the perforation during manufacturing. For EX0000997, EX0000998, and EX0001001 -EX0001003, the deletion of (b) (4) in the tipping paper ink of the original tobacco products and the addition of (b) (4) in the tipping paper ink of the new tobacco products is a minor modification. This modification resulted in a change in composition of the tipping paper ink but did not alter the overall total amount of tipping paper ink as these two additives were changed at equal amounts. Also, for EX0000997 only, the existing additive of (b) (4) in the tipping paper ink was increased by (b) (4) mg/cigarette. Overall, these modifications are not expected to materially affect any other characteristic (materials, ingredients, design, composition, heating source, or other features) of the tobacco products. Lastly, FDA finds, based on the information contained in the Exemption Requests and CTP's scientific understanding, that an exemption for these modifications is otherwise appropriate as required by section 905(j)(3)(a)(iii) of the FD&C Act. Therefore, the new tobacco products should be found exempt from the requirements of substantial equivalence under section 910(a)(3)(A) of the FD&C Act.

The original tobacco products are eligible for modification through the Exemption Request pathway because they can be legally marketed in the United States. For EX0000997, EX0000998, and EX0001000 – EX0001003, the original tobacco products are grandfathered products (i.e., were commercially marketed in the United States other than exclusively test markets as of February 15, 2007). For EX0000999, the original tobacco product is previously found Exempt by

FDA, a report under section 905(j)(1)(A)(ii) (an Abbreviated Report) was submitted, and 90 days have elapsed since FDA receipt of the Abbreviated Report.

For EX0000997, EX0000998, and EX0001000 – EX0001003, FDA has examined the environmental effects of finding the new tobacco products exempt and made a finding of no significant impact.

An Exempt order should be issued for the new tobacco products in EX0000997, EX0000998, and EX0001000 – EX0001003, as identified on the cover page of this review.

For EX0000999, FDA has examined the environmental effects of finding this new tobacco product exempt from substantial equivalence and found that additional information is necessary to determine the impact of the action. Without this information, FDA is precluded from issuing an Exempt order.

An Environmental Information Request letter should be issued requesting the following information:

1. EX0000999 indicates that the original tobacco product will not continue to be marketed upon receiving a marketing order for the new tobacco product. However, your EX Request includes conflicting statements regarding current marketing status for the original tobacco product. On page 16 of the EX Request, you state that the original tobacco product "is currently on the market but will be replaced in the marketplace by the new product." On page 20 of the EX Request, you state that the "new product will replace the already discontinued [original] product." Clarify if the original tobacco product is currently marketed. If so, provide current market volume for the original tobacco product. Marketing information is used to assess the cumulative environmental impacts of concurrent manufacturing, use, and disposal of the new and original tobacco products. Table 1 can be used to present this information.

If the applicant adequately responds to the request and an EIS or FONSI is completed, an EX order should be issued for the new tobacco product in EX0000999, as identified on the cover page of this review.
