Duties include:

The selected employee will serve as Health Scientist in matters pertaining to the Center's policy needs and activities relating to the regulation of tobacco products and its effect on public health, use and prevention. Knowledge of population health and tobacco regulatory science, coupled with strong oral and written communication skills to provide advice to the DPHS, IO on regulatory, research and review data related matters affecting the division. Duties include:

- Design and implement scientific studies, analyzes data, and interprets results related to population health and tobacco regulatory science to support policy or program development and evaluation.
- Advise management on issues related to scientific regulatory subject matters and existing and proposed policies, programs, and regulations to include product review, surveillance, research, and regulations;
- Serve as a health scientist expert in the evaluation of tobacco product regulations and effects on public health;
- Use research methods to review scientific materials.
