Patient Care and Clinic Development:

As the Director of the Oncogeriatrics Program, I conceived, developed, and implemented a multi-disciplinary care model for aging adults with blood cancer. This clinic is a first of its kind in the division of Hematology. The Blood Cancer and Aging Clinic, is one of only a few programs nationally, dedicated to a multi-disciplinary approach to address health factors unique to the aging adult. I direct a team of 6 providers (pharmacist, nutritionist, nurse, case manager, physical therapist, and audiologist) to create a unique care plan to improve clinical outcomes for aging adults with blood cancer. The clinic model has

since been presented nationally and the care model has been disseminated to many national groups looking to model our multidisciplinary approach.

Our clinic was given a Certificate of Award in June of 2016 for Cancer and Aging Care Delivery by the Service Board at the Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center.
